**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**ALENZA Basal Oil BLUE** is a low viscosity non-aromatic/non-carcinogenic diluent with nonionic surfactants and selected emulsifiers. **ALENZA Basal Oil BLUE** is designed for basal-bark and cut-surface brush control applications with oil-soluble herbicides, such as \*GARLON 4®, which are registered for woody plant vegetation control.

**ALENZA Basal Oil BLUE** is approved for use in industrial rights-of-way, forestry and other non-cropland applications that require an oil diluent as a penetrant.

**USE RECOMMENDATIONS**

**ALENZA Basal Oil BLUE** can be used at dilution ratios of 1:4 (20%) or 1:3 (25%) when following the herbicide manufacturer's label recommendations. Test **ALENZA Basal Oil BLUE** for compatibility with the herbicide before mixing for use.

**NOTE:** Use rates may vary dependent on environmental conditions and applications. Increase rates as necessary for additional wetting and penetration. Follow recommendations and label rates of herbicide manufacturers.

**FIRST AID**

**Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.**

**If Swallowed:** Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

**If Inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

**If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
