**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:** Do not use in water that is expected to be consumed by humans. **ALENZA Blue Diamond** is safe for swimming after complete dispersal. Use **ALENZA Blue Diamond** only in water bodies that have restricted flow.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**ALENZA Blue Diamond** is a flexible, concentrated formulation that is a non-toxic water colorant. **ALENZA Blue Diamond** creates a beautiful natural appearance for your lake and pond. This product is an excellent complement to the already existing beauty of golf courses and park fountains.

**ALENZA Blue Diamond** is safe to fish and aquatic species, water fowl, wildlife and pets. It is a non-corrosive dye and when used according to recommended rates will not stain stone, fountains, approved aquatic features or swimwear. The dye will stain rocks, decking and other porous surfaces if spilled or applied as a concentrate.

### FIRST AID

**Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.**

**If Swallowed:** Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

**If Inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

**If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

### APPLICATION RATES

**ALENZA Blue Diamond** should be applied one (1) gallon of dye per acre of water with an average water depth of four (4) feet. One (1) ounce treats approximately eight thousand, five hundred (8500) gallons of water for small ponds. An acre/foot of water can be determined using the following formula:

$$\text{Pond Length (ft)} \times \text{Pond Width (ft)} \times \text{Average Depth (ft)} / 43,560 \text{ ft}^3 = 1 \text{ Acre/Foot of Water.}$$

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Pour the appropriate amount of dye into the water along the edge of the lake or pond. **ALENZA Blue Diamond** will distribute evenly, dispersing with lake and pond currents, and wind-blown water movement. To assist diffusion throughout the entire lake or pond, empty the gallon container(s) at different points around the lake or pond edge, or through an aerator, circulation or injection system, waterfall or fountain. Wear eye protection and rubber gloves, carefully applying the dye directly to the water.

**ALENZA Blue Diamond** is a high-quality, aquatic dye that will be degraded by chlorine, which will diminish the lake or pond coloration. In non-chlorinated systems or lakes and ponds, dye is broken down gradually through biological and photodegradation. Coloration is also reduced through the natural process of dilution (i.e. – addition of fresh water to the lake or pond). The original color level should be stable for 2-4 weeks, depending on your lake or pond system. Chlorinated systems typically require dye addition within 2 weeks, while biological and photodegradation is common within 4 weeks. To return your beautiful lake or pond color to its intended coloration level, simply add small amounts of **ALENZA Blue Diamond** from time to time. This will offset the natural color loss, that occurs in every dyed lake or pond environment.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store above 32°F to prevent freezing. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse. Then offer container for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in an approved waste disposal facility, or other procedures in accordance with Federal, State and Local regulations.
