FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL is a dry, dispersible drift polymer for use with pesticide sprays, to improve deposition and reduce fines, by increasing the internal cohesive of spray droplets.

ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL is compatible with most pesticide formulations, except the potassium salt of glyphosate, and may be used by both ground and aerial application equipment.

The degree of drift hazard varies with the type of pesticide, application conditions, and vegetation near the sprayed area. Pesticide drift is no accident. Common sense and sound application technology must be followed when spraying pesticides. **ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL** should be used as a management tool to reduce drift, but not totally eliminate drift.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL disperses very well but needs time for the polymer to hydrate to perform drop management.

ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL is compatible with fertilizer and other nutrient materials.

MIXING or USE RATES

Fill spray tank half full with water and begin agitation. Continue agitation while adding pesticides. Add **ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL** before adding emulsifiable concentrates and oil type additives, as they may coat the particle and increase time needed to hydrate. Sprinkle desired amount of **ALENZA GRANULAR DRIFT CONTROL** over the point of most vigorous agitation. Dumping in large amounts could result in lumps forming, which take a long time to dissolve.

SUGGESTED RATES:

	Pressure	Ground & Aerial
	Below 20 psi	2 to 4 oz per 100 gallons
	Below 40 psi	3 to 5 oz per 100 gallons
	Above 40 psi	4 to 8 oz per 100 gallons

Using too much drift polymer can interfere with the pattern of spray nozzles causing skips and performance. Start by using lower rate and slowly increase until desired affect is obtained. Higher pressures and smaller nozzles will produce more fines and driftable spray droplets.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store product in a cool, dry place in the original container. Keep container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Sweep up spills and dispose of wastes on-site or at approved waste disposal facility. Completely empty the container and triple rinse or equivalent. Offer container for recycling or dispose of container in sanitary landfill or by procedures approved by appropriate authorities.
