

INTERSTATES 64, 85, 95 AND 295 - VIRGINIA

Virginia Department of Transportation

DBi Services provides Total Asset Maintenance Services (TAMS) for contract #483/#499 and #143 for VDOT on I-64, I-95, I-85 and I-295 in the Richmond, Staunton, Culpepper and Hampton Roads District. Both contracts include maintenance of the roadways, structures, incident and emergency response, snow and ice removal, hurricane clean up and response, and bridge maintenance.

The TAMS I-85, I-95 and I-295 contract include 621 lane miles within the right-of-way, beginning at the North Carolina state line and continuing north into Richmond. This is a 5-year contract that began in 2012 and had a 5-year renewal option that was executed due to the success of the first term.

The TAMS I-64 contract includes 344 lane miles of limited access interstate. This contract runs for five years with two optional two-year renewals.

Project Highlights

When DBi Services assumed operations from the previous contractor, many assets such as roadway and bridges were not within contract standards. DBi Services has worked diligently to raise the Maintenance Rating Performance (MRP) scores of these particular assets and has kept them within compliance.

DBi Services has had tremendous success with snow and ice operations with these contracts. The project emergency team mobilizes over 90 pieces of equipment approximately 10 times a year to respond to snow and ice events.
